On God's Agenda

How one man stayed on it

Anyone who has been to Haiti with us or read our newsletters for the past 16 years knows about Joël. People mistakenly thought he was our "hired driver" but they soon realized he was the one who took care of nearly everything for us in Haiti. He kept our vehicles at his house in Jacmel, then would drive to Port-au-Prince whenever we arrived either alone or with a team. He'd arrange ministry in advance for us under my direction. He was our most trusted friend and true associate in ministry.

As a young man, Joël was moving up in the soccer world, and had potential to join the Haitian national team. But the Lord spoke clearly to him and told him that the lifestyle of a soccer player would draw him far from God's plans for his life, and he left soccer to simply seek the Lord and stay on whatever path God would choose for him.

Through the years, hearing me preach and teach on revival countless times, Joël became more spiritually wise than most pastors. He became a trusted Elder in his church, and as we would travel together I would often see him talking individually to pastors and leaders to further clarify what I was teaching. Joël is a deep worshipper and prayer warrior, and I always feel safe and secure when with him; he is the most trustworthy man I know in Haiti.

When we moved to Haiti, we weren't sure what to do about Joël. How we longed to have him at our side, but there was no possibility to move his entire family to Port-au-Prince and fund both house and schools for them. So here we were living in Haiti but far from Joël, only seeing him occasionally if we needed his help with a visiting mission team.

But God had a plan for Joël. Only a couple blocks from our house is an orphanage named Child Hope. It is managed by a couple who have become very close friends. They needed someone who could manage some of the Haitian staff plus live with and mentor the orphan boys. Today Joël has that position; a full-time job that I could never offer him, a much-increased salary, and a spiritual ministry in which he can live out all that he has received from us through our years together. While the orphanage is preparing living quarters for his entire family, Joël works six days a week and visits his family each weekend. Soon the whole family will be here together, only two blocks from us.

In the meantime, I have become the "pastor" for Child Hope, leading a worship service each Saturday night for kids and staff, plus a growing number of people from the community who hear me sing and preach in Creole and come to join the inspiration and prayer.

We are believing God that He wants to raise up revival right here in the zone in which we live through a move of the Spirit at Child Hope. I will also be leading a weekly meeting for worship leaders, singers, and musicians on the orphanage grounds that we pray will attract many others from a wider area.

At the same time, Margie is beginning to teach the younger children who have special needs in the orphanage, while also starting a "bakery" program for some of the older ones who are getting ready to leave the orphanage (Haitian law says they cannot stay after turning 18).

So God simply re-arranged a few things while giving Joël a ministry of his own and still preserving our unity and closeness. Isn't He amazing?
